
What is Mental Health First Aid?


- Help offered to a person developing a mental health problem or experiencing a mental health crisis
- Given until appropriate treatment and support are received or until the crisis resolves
- Not a substitute for counseling, medical care, peer support or treatment



Why Mental Health First Aid?

- Mental health problems are common
- Stigma is associated with mental health problems
- Professional help is not always on hand
- Individuals with mental health problems often do not seek help
- Many people...
 - > are not well informed about mental health problems
 - > do not know how to respond



Instructor Certification Process

- Candidates go through the five-day or three-day training
- Course times vary but they do run for a full 8 hours
- Each instructor candidate will present and teach an assigned portion of the 8-hour course to the group
- National Trainers will conduct an individual evaluation of each candidate, and each candidate will provide a peer review for their colleagues

Hosting Your Own Training

Host Site Instructor Certification Training Fees

- > **Flat fee:** \$36,200 for an on-site 5-day Instructor Training for up to 30 people maximum
- > **Flat fee:** \$21,500 for an on-site 3-day Instructor Training for up to 15 individuals

What's Included:

- > Trainer fees for two nationally certified trainers
- > Trainer travel and per diem costs
- > Trainer lodging
- > Program materials for each participant (teaching kit which includes participant manual, teaching notes, flash drive with program PowerPoint, handouts, and other related program materials; stuffed koala mascot)
- > Training materials (handouts, exercises, giveaways, etc.)
- > Printing, shipping, and processing of training materials to training site
- > Supplies for training (art supplies, markers, tape, etc.)

FAQs: Becoming an Instructor

- Who can become an instructor?
- Who *should* become an instructor?
- What is the instructor's role in teaching the course?

FAQs: Submitting an Application

- Does everyone need to submit an application to become an instructor?
- How does someone submit an application?
- When will the candidate hear back about their application?
- I found a list of future training dates but no venue locations, how do obtain venue location to make travel arrangements?



FAQs: Instructor Certification

- How are instructors certified?
- How do instructors maintain certification?
- If I am an instructor, may I certify other instructors?
- Can a certification be transferred to another personnel?
- Is the Spanish version of the Adult or Youth training available?
- sthe curriculum offered in other languages?
- What if the individual is seeking to become dual certified?
- Can I become certified in a curriculum module?



FAQs: Course Delivery

- Can instructors break the curriculum up into sections?
- Once someone is an instructor, how many people can they train at a time?
- How much time can elapse between these sections?
- Can an instructor teach the course alone, or does they need a training partner?

FAQs: Course Materials and Evaluation

- How big a room is needed and how should it be set up?
- Do I need to include resource lists?
- Does every First Aider need a manual?
 - > NOTE: once an individual becomes a certified instructor, they may purchase manuals
- Does every participant need to complete an evaluation?
- Can I cut slides or other exercises to fit into the 8 hours?
