



Find teen Mental Health First Aid Instructor Training Courses

Is your organization considering training 10 or more teen Mental Health First Aid (tMHFA) Instructors? If so, hosting a private virtual instructor training may be the best option. Please email us at

IMPORTANT UPDATE: With news about COVID-19 developing rapidly – and with your health top of mind – all tMHFA Instructor trainings will be conducted remotely until October 2020. The virtual training will cover the same content as in-person training, and you will be eligible for full Instructor certification. This is three days of live, interactive training presented by tMHFA National Trainers. Each day of instruction will run six to eight hours.

Please note: Before Instructors can apply to attend an upcoming tMHFA Instructor Training, organizations must apply to the National Council for Behavioral Health and be registered as tMHFA Implementing Sites. Once accepted, tMHFA Implementing Sites may invite Instructor candidates to apply to attend a three-day tMHFA Instructor Training.

tMHFA Instructor Training Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis. We recommend submitting your application as soon as possible.

After you are accepted as a tMHFA Instructor candidate, you will receive an email asking you to select your training location preferences. We will register you for a training session based on those preferences. If your preferred trainings are full, we will email you a list of alternatives. **We will update this page as new information becomes available, so please check back here often.**
